

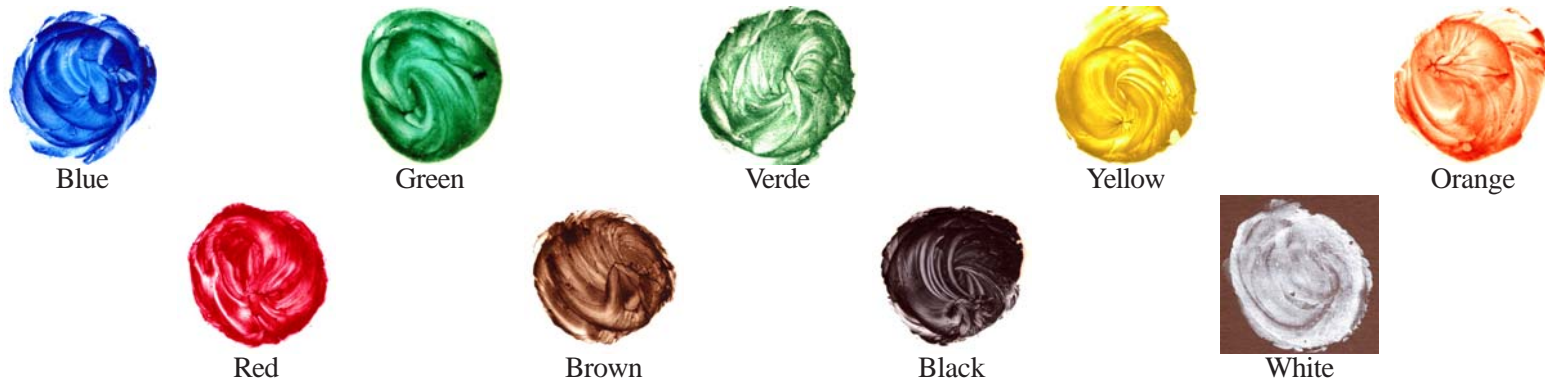
Solvent Dyes ★ The star indicates a non-acid product.

Solvent Dyes are used cold (room temperature) and can be applied directly on any metal, Metal Coating, or other material. They may be used over a dry patina to alter the color or they may be used to duplicate a chemical patina. They are concentrated colors that are added to lacquer, wax, epoxy, oils, resin, our Dye Thinner, or any other solvent product. The colors may be blended together to create different shades. All of the colors are transparent except white.



Metal Waxes ★ The star indicates a non-acid product.

Until now there has never been a wax made specifically for metals, especially metals with a patina finish. Sculpt Nouveau has taken the finest quality waxes known for metal to make an special blend: carnauba, microcrystalline, & clear bees wax. This blend is truly a delight for anyone working with metal, metal coatings, and resin castings. The wax is made in the nine colors below, as well as clear. Each color of wax is made in two formulas – one for Bronze, Brass, Copper, & Aluminum – and the other for Iron & Steel.



Starred items may be used on any type of metal without causing rust (including iron, steel, and aluminum). The color will remain unchanged.
These are non-reactive, UV stable products. They may also be used to stain concrete, ceramics, and wood.
